Lead by the European Commission, the WiFi4EU scheme aims to promote free WiFi connectivity for citizens and visitors in public spaces such as parks, squares, public buildings, libraries, health centres, and museums everywhere in Europe. During his presentation of the project, Jean-Claude Juncker, President of the European Commission, highlighted the importance of providing free wireless internet access around the main centres of public life by 2020.

Alex Puregger, CEO of Fon, commented, "It is fantastic news that the European Union will invest €120 million in providing free internet access in municipalities over the next few years. Our solution for managed WiFi services is unique within the industry, and with it we want to support all system integrators interested in this initiative by offering WiFi services in an easy and scalable way."
